DO NOT place used needles or any other medical waste with recycling! This is a serious health hazard to everyone!





Rapho Township residents may dispose of two (2) bulk items per

week through curb side collection. Bulk items must have Extra

ACCEPTED MATERIALS - Furniture, mattresses, box springs, lawn mowers (oil and gasoline removed), plumbing fixtures such as toilets and sinks, and 5 feet of carpet rolled and tied.

NON-ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS – Chemicals, stains, liquids, batteries, automobile parts, hazardous waste, tires on rims, commercial/industrial waste, construction materials (drywall, brick, block, lumber, shingles, tiles, concrete).

ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS – Items which are too heavy to be lifted into a truck by two people will not be accepted. Additional trash bags are NOT considered a bulk item.

Tires (without rims), White Goods & appliances with Freon will be collected twice a year (must have extra service tag). Collection dates are on the calendar in this flyer. These items include but are not limited to air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, etc.

#### BASIC RESIDENTIAL GUIDELINES



= White Good & Leaf Collection

= Yard Waste Collection

- Trash, Recycling, and two bulk items (must use extra service tags) must be curb side by 5:00 AM on your scheduled collection day.
- No more than three (3) trash bags/cans will be collected each week.
- · Bags or containers must not exceed 32 gallons or 30 pounds.
- Yard waste must not exceed 4 feet in length, 30 pounds and must be bundled.
- · Yard Waste will be collected on the 4th Saturday of the month, beginning in April and ending in October. (See calendar above)
- Bulk items that are too heavy to be lifted into a truck by two people will not be accepted.
- First collection for Monday customers will be on June 30th, 2014. (See Map for collection days)
- · No construction debris will be collected curb side.

# **Acceptable Items**

#### METAL:

- Aluminum beverage cans
- Steel food & beverage cans, aerosol cans, empty paint cans

#### **GLASS:**

- Clear, brown, blue, and green glass food & beverage containers
- ✓ Remove caps/lids
- ✓ Rinse thoroughly to remove all contaminants
- ✓ It is OK to leave on labels and neck rings

#### PAPER. PAPERBOARD & CARDBOARD: **Recycle Any Size. Any Quantity.**

Please break down boxes as flat as possible and put them out next to our recycle bin(s) on your pick-up day.

- All sizes of cardboard boxes
- Clean pizza boxes
- Food boxes (i.e. cereal & gelatin boxes)
- EMPTY paper towel and toilet paper rolls
- Paperboard packaging (i.e. tissue boxes)
- Office paper (any color)

- · Newspapers and inserts
- · Magazines, catalogs, and brochures
- Envelopes & junk mail

- ✓ Remove all packaging (Styrofoam, peanuts, plastic bubble) wrap, plastic liners, etc.)

- ✓ Cover loose paper with heavier items to prevent it from
- ✓ If the weather forecast calls for high winds or wet weather, if possible, keep your paper recyclables until the next week. Wet paper products are difficult to process.

# **Trash Collection Days for Opt-In Customers**

Beginning June 30th, Penn Waste will begin to collect at the homes that have opted-in to Rapho Township's Trash & Recycling contract. Collection days will be on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. The collection areas are based off of the voting districts, with the exception of Sporting Hill. Monday collections will occur for customers residing in the Union Square district and the Sporting Hill district, including both sides of North Colebrook Road and both sides of Hossler Road from North Colebrook Road/Fairview Road east to Mount Joy Road. Monday collections are displayed in blue on the map to the right. Customers residing in the Elm Tree 1 district and Sporting Hill district south of Hossler Road (to include both sides of Fairview Road, Esbenshade Road and Mount Joy Road), will be collected on Tuesday. Tuesday collections are displayed in green on the map to the right. Customers residing in the Elm Tree 2 and Willow Creek districts will be collected on Wednesday, which is displayed in orange on the map to the right. # Yard Waste Collection Guidelines

Yard Waste is material such as tree trimmings. shrubbery and other organic landscape vegetation not listed below.

For a full Yard Waste collection schedule, please refer to the calendar included.

#### DO NOT place these items out for yard waste collection:













#### How to Prepare Yard Waste

- 1. Place vard waste in biodegradable brown paper bags or bundle it with biodegradable twine in easy-to-handle bundles.
  - Bundles may be no longer than 4 feet in length.
  - Bundles may not weigh more than 30 pounds each.
  - Bundles may not exceed 6 inches in diameter.
- 2. Once prepared, yard waste must be placed at the curb on scheduled pick up day before 5:00 am.
- An unlimited number of bags or bundles may be placed at the curb.
