Important Solid Waste & Recycling Collection Information for 2013

IMPORTANT TRASH & RECYCLING INFORMATION FOR SILVER SPRING TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS

Dear Silver Spring Township Resident,

Please be advised that Penn Waste, Inc has been awarded the new Solid Waste & Recycling Collection contract with Silver Spring Township for the term of 10/1/12 - 9/30/15. We look forward to servicing the residents of Silver Spring Township. Our goal is to provide you with superior customer service. Please review the contents of this flyer for useful information on your collection service.

Please have your items placed at the curb prior to 6:00 AM as we will start promptly. Your collection day will remain the same as your previous contract. Your weekly collection will consist of the following options below. Penn Waste will be billing you directly under this contract. Your first quarterly bill will be sent in September 2012 and will cover the 4th quarter of 2012.

Penn Waste is the exclusive hauler for Silver Spring Township under this contract. The rates and service levels are as follows:

Trash	Recycle	Bulk Item	Rate
Option 1 - Unlimited - 40 lb limit 40 gallon containers	Unlimited	1 per week	\$38.20 per quarter
* Option 2 - Pay per Bag 24 bag minimum	Unlimited	1 per week (Must attach bag to bulk item)	\$84.00 per year (Billed Annually)

*For Option 2, you must purchase a minimum of 24 bags per year. If you need extra bags, they may be purchased in lots of 24 only, at the township office. Smaller quantities of bags may be purchased through Penn Waste at \$3.50 each plus shipping costs. This option also includes one bulk item per week, but a "Pay per Bag" must be attached to your large item.

Penn Waste Toters are available for \$18.00 per quarter.

Recycle Today To Save Tomorrow!

Here's how you can help:

1. Place your recycling bin out for collection on your scheduled pick up day.
2. When placing paper products in recycling bins with other recyclables, be sure paper is covered by heavier material so it doesn't blow away!
3. Bundle any large, loose pieces of cardboard that will not fit in your recycling bin.
4. Remember that we accept unlimited amounts of recyclables.
5. Check out the guidelines on the rest of this sheet to learn how to recycle successfully.

Fast Facts:

- For paper products, if it tears, it's recyclable.
- We accept any size and quantity of cardboard.
- There is no need to separate recycling, we have a Single Stream Facility, which sorts the recyclables.

Containers

Recycle These Items:

Plastics

#1-#7 containers & bottles with necks smaller than their bases

Glass

Clear, brown & green glass food and beverage containers

Metal Cans

Aluminum beverage cans
Steel food and beverage cans
Aerosol cans

Prepare

1. Remove caps/lids
2. Rinse thoroughly
3. It is okay to leave on labels and neck rings



Unacceptable:

- NEEDLES (Do NOT place used needles with recycling! This is a serious health hazard for everyone.)
- Plastic tubs, cups & trays
- Broken glass
- Aluminum foil
- Scrap metal
- Tupperware or disposable plastic containers
- Plastic Tableware (knives, forks, spoons, etc.)
- Plastic grocery bags
- Light bulbs
- All solvent, oil & chemical containers

Paper, Paperboard & Cardboard

Recycle These Items:

Cardboard boxes
Pizza boxes
Food boxes (e.g. cereal & jello boxes)
Empty Paper towel & toilet paper rolls
Paperboard packaging (e.g. tissue boxes)
Office paper (any color)
Shredded paper (in clear plastic bags please)
Newspapers & inserts
Magazines, catalogs & brochures
Junk mail & envelopes
Paper bags
Phone books & other soft cover books

Prepare

1. Remove all packaging (styrofoam, peanuts, plastic, bubble wrap, plastic liners, etc.)
2. Flatten all boxes
3. Bundle cardboard that does not fit into

the recycling bin

4. Cover loose paper with heavier containers to prevent it from blowing away
5. Check weather forecast: If the forecast calls for high winds or rain, keep your paper products inside until the following week if possible

Unacceptable:

- Plastic Bags
- Food soiled material
- Paperboard Juice Containers
- Soaked and/or wet papers or cardboard
- Plastic food wrappers
- Used paper towels or tissues





Silver Spring Township residents may dispose of one (1) bulk item per week through curbside collection. Please have your waste, recycling, and bulk item available for collection at the curb by 6:00 AM.



ACCEPTED MATERIALS - appliances, furniture, mattresses, box springs, one (1) car tire without the rim, lawn mowers (oil and gasoline removed), plumbing fixtures such as toilets and sinks, also three (3) 4 ft. rolls of carpet (tied) equals one bulk item.

NON-ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS - chemicals, stains, liquids, batteries, automobile parts, hazardous waste, tires on rims, commercial/industrial waste, construction materials (drywall, brick, block, lumber, shingles, tiles, concrete)

Additional Instructions: Items which are too heavy to be lifted into a truck by two people will not be accepted. Additional trash bags are NOT considered a bulk item.

Bulk Item Guidelines



Appliances with Freon will be collected by appointment only. Please call Penn Waste at 717-767-4456 to schedule collection. (Items include, but are not limited to air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, etc)



Yard Waste Collection Guidelines

Yard Waste is material such as tree trimmings, shrubbery and any other organic landscape vegetation not listed below. (does not include leaves)

DO NOT place these items out for yard waste collection:

Grass Clippings



Fruits & Vegetables



Tree Stumps



Dirt & Stones



How to Prepare Yard Waste

1. Place yard waste in biodegradable brown paper bags, separate trash container or bundle it with biodegradable twine in easy-to-handle bundles.
 - Bundles may be no longer than five feet in length.
 - Bundles may not weigh more than 30 pounds each.
 - Branches may not exceed six inches in diameter.
2. Once prepared, yard waste must be placed at the curb on scheduled pick up day before 6:00 am.
3. An unlimited number of bags or bundles may be placed at the curb.

Please prepare your yard waste properly.
Yard Waste in plastic bags WILL NOT be collected!

= Yard Waste Collection

Observed holidays are noted in **RED**. Collection days that fall on or after the holiday will be delayed one day.
EXCEPTION: If holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, there is **no change** in service prior to or after the holiday.

Basic Residential Guidelines

- Trash, Recycling, and one bulk item must be curbside by 6:00 am on your scheduled collection day, which will be remaining the same.
- Bags or containers must not exceed 40 gallons or 40 pounds .
- Yard waste must not exceed 5 feet in lengths and must be bundled.
- Call Penn Waste to schedule collection of appliances containing Freon (ex. air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, etc.)
- No construction debris will be collected curbside.
